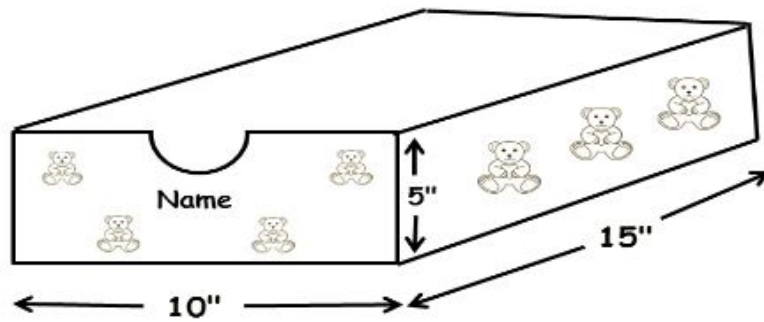

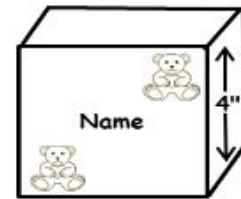
Cubby Hole Box

To: The parents of Kindergarten Students.

We would like to have each child bring a cardboard box or 1/2 quart plastic container for his/her cubby hole. Below is a sketch this box. The measurements are approximate, but shouldn't be larger than specified.

If possible, please cover the box with contact paper and cut a slot in front as indicated in the sketch. Please label the front of the box with your child's first and last name. You may want to look for Penzoil boxes or a 1/2 quart plastic container without a lid. No contact paper is necessary, if using a plastic container.

Dear Parents:

We need your help to prepare items of comfort for your child in the case of a statewide emergency while in the care of our Makalapa Elementary Faculty and Staff. This emergency preparedness includes preparing your child in case of a ballistic missile threat to the State of Hawaii.

Prepare your child's "GO BAG"

As this may be an unsettling time for your child, we are asking for your assistance in creating a GO bag for each of your children at Makalapa Elementary. These bags are designed to provide necessary information in case of emergency, but also to provide comfort. Your child's GO BAG will be kept with your homeroom teacher during the school year, and returned to you at the end of the year.

- Families should fill one gallon baggie with:
 - Picture of family and a note of encouragement
 - Nut free or other snacks

- Families can fill the remainder of space with things like:
 - Glow sticks
 - Ponchos
 - Small blanket or soft toy
 - Hand Sanitizer

The classrooms are stocked with water, first aid supplies, restroom supplies, and towels. Every teacher will be equipped with a hand-cranked solar emergency weather/NOAA band transistor radio and LED flashlight.

Picking up your Child after a State/School-wide emergency:

When the statewide emergency has concluded and when it is safe for you to pick up your child, we will again notify you of our family reunification procedures via our Synrevoice telephone notification system, e-mail, the Makalapa Elementary website, and our PTA Facebook page. Our notification will include information about procedures for family reunification; determination of school opening date; and return to school information.

Our Staff with your child's teacher will assist with reunification with your child and/or school closure.

Thank you parents and guardians for your efforts to prepare your child for a statewide emergency. As we cannot predict when, where, and/or whether such an emergency will occur, our Faculty and Staff at Makalapa Elementary are prepared to provide care, shelter, and compassion for your child in case of any emergency.
